Cocktail of the Month

LULU'S BLOODY BULL

2 ounces vodka Juice of half a lemon

Juice of quarter of a lime

2 pinches celery salt

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1/2 teaspoon Pickapeppa® sauce 3-4 splashes LuLu's Perfect Pepper Hot Sauce

2 ounces beef stock

3 ounces Mott's Clamato juice or V8 100% vegetable juice Lemon or lime wedges, celery stalks, olives, pickled beans, pickled okra, or cucumber wedges (or anything else from the garden) to garnish

- 1. Fill a tall glass with ice
- 2. Add vodka
- Add lemon and lime juices, celery salt,
 Worcestershire sauce,
 Pickapeppa sauce, hot sauce, and beef stock
- 4. Fill with Clamato juice
- 5. Toss in a shaker cup
- 6. Pour back into alass
- 7. Garnish as desired



Lala Clae: Au jus from a pot roast works incredibly well in this drink in place of beef stock. More options: garnish with a large shrimp or bleu cheese-stuffed olives. You can also rim the glass with Old Bay" seasoning.



Eric Erdman was writing songs at 8 years old. When he and his older brother sat at the end of their family's pier on Mobile Bay, they learned to play guitar to the rhythm of the waves. Eric Erdman's accomplishments as a quitarist, producer, and songwriter speak volumes about his talent and drive in the music industry. In addition to tons of session work, Eric has played lead guitar for the likes of The Buddy Rich Band, Kristy Lee, and Nadirah Shakoor. He has produced dozens of albums; including five solo albums and another five for his former band, The Ugli Stick. It is on the stage, however, that Eric's true genius is fully realized. The authenticity of his songwriting is matched by a playing style and voice equally as authentic. Eric brings an element of wisdom and wittiness that is incredibly captivating. He seems to compel audiences to hang on his every word. When you see Eric perform, and hear his songs, it is obvious that he has loved and lost; that he has felt the highs and lows that life can bring. And yet, Eric finds a way to synthesize meaning, and even humor, from those experiences.
